BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager and his designee are authorized severally to enter into an agreement with the Union Pacific Railroad for the purpose of improving railroad operations and increasing traffic safety in the vicinity of Comal and Morales Streets. In connection therewith, the Interim City Manager and his designee are authorized and directed severally to execute and deliver an agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, which is incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as if it were fully set forth. The Interim City Manager and his designee are further authorized and directed severally to execute and deliver all other documents and do all other things necessary or convenient to effect the transaction contemplated hereby.

SECTION 2. No money is changing hands directly as a result of the passage of this ordinance. No financial impact.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective June 26, 2005 unless it receives the eight votes requisite to immediate effectiveness under San Antonio Municipal Code § 1-15, in which case it is effective immediately.
