

AN ORDINANCE 101058

ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY NABCO, INC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH A TOTAL REPLACEMENT CONTAINMENT VESSEL AND TREATMENT SYSTEM (BOMB CONTAINER) FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$461,000.00, FROM URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT FUNDS.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with a total replacement containment vessel and treatment system (bomb container) which will enhance the capabilities of the Bomb Squad when dealing with explosive devices and will also create a safer environment by containing the detonation within the container to prevent injuries and major damage to property; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by UXB International, Inc., bid no. 1 and 2, failed to meet the City specifications; and

WHEREAS, Nabco, Inc. was the low responsive bidder for a total contract cost of \$461,000.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low, responsive bid of Nabco, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Police department with a total replacement containment vessel and treatment system (bomb container) for a total cost of \$461,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. The bid and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bids of UXB International, Inc., bids no. 1 and 2 failed to meet the City's specifications.

SECTION 3. Funding in the amount of \$461,000.00 is approved for purchase of a total containment vessel and treatment system for the San Antonio Police Departments as appropriated in existing SAP Fund 26065000, entitled "Urban Area Security Grant".

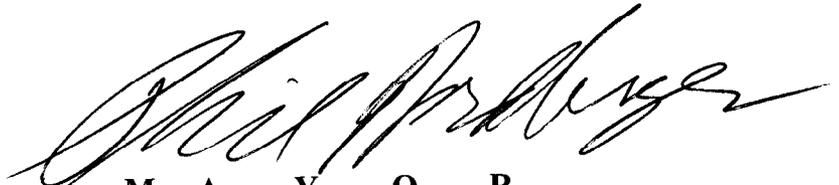
SECTION 4. The amount of \$461,000.00 will be encumbered by purchase order and payable to Nabco Inc. from SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order No. 117000000051 for the above said system.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the

Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers and Internal orders as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect July 3rd, 2005.
