

AN ORDINANCE **101404**

AUTHORIZING ESTABLISHING AND AMENDING VARIOUS FEES CHARGES FOR GROUND TRANSPORTATION, VEHICLE TOWING AND STORAGE, AND PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES, RESULTING IN ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND; AND AMENDING THE CORRESPONDING SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase certain established fees charged and to establish additional fees to be charged in connection with services provided by the San Antonio Police Department in order to recover the costs of providing those services; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Section 19-435 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

A person seeking issuance of a parade permit shall file an application with the chief of police on forms provided by such officer.

(1) *Filing period.* The application shall be filed with the chief of police not less than thirty (30) days nor more than one hundred twenty (120) days before the proposed parade date.

(2) *Contents.* The application shall set forth the following information:

a. The name, address and telephone number of the person seeking to conduct such parade.

b. If the parade is to be held for or by an organization, the name, address and telephone number of the headquarters of the organization, and of the authorized and responsible heads of such organization.

c. If the parade is to be held by or for any person other than the applicant, the applicant shall file a writing from that other person showing authority to make the application.

d. The name, address and telephone number of the person who will be the parade chairman and who will be responsible for its conduct.

e. The date when the parade is to be conducted.

f. The proposed route, the initial starting point and the disbanding area.

g. If the parade will be held in whole or in part in the downtown area then the applicant shall choose a designated route provided in section 19-441.

h. The approximate number of persons who, and animals and vehicles which, will constitute such parade; the type of animals, and description of the vehicles.

- i. The time when such parade will start and terminate.
 - j. A statement as to whether the parade will occupy all or only a portion of the width of the streets proposed to be used.
 - k. The location by streets of any assembly areas for such parade.
 - l. The time at which units of the parade will arrive at the assembly area.
 - m. The interval of space to be maintained between units of such parade, and the estimated time past a given point.
 - n. Any other information which the chief of police shall find necessary under the standards for issuance, hereinafter set forth in section 19-436.
 - o. The purpose(s) of the parade.
- (3) *Late applications.* The chief of police, where good cause is shown, may consider any application filed after the deadline prescribed in subsection (1) above.
- (4) *Application fee.* Each application shall be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 for a Category 1 event (1 – 10 officers required); \$100.00 for a Category 2 event (11 – 25 officers required); \$150.00 for a Category 3 event (26 – 75 officers required); and \$200.00 for a Category 4 event (76 or greater officers required).

SECTION 2. Section 19-451 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

A person seeking issuance of a permit hereunder shall file an application with the chief of police or his designated representative on a form provided by such officer.

- (1) *Filing period.* The application shall be filed with the chief of police not less than thirty (30) days nor more than one hundred twenty (120) days before the proposed event.
- (2) *Conditional approval.* The permit holder for a run, walk or cycling event actually held during a prior year may receive conditional approval of the course, date and time not more than thirteen (13) months in advance of the scheduled date of the event. Conditional approval may be given by the chief of police or his designated representative upon written request by the permit holder. The permit holder for a run, walk or cycling event shall receive right of first refusal as to the date, time and course of the event up to one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the date of event.
- (3) *Late applications.* The chief of police where good cause is shown, may consider any application filed after the deadline prescribed in subsection one (1) above.
- (4) *Application fee.* Each application shall be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 for a Category 1 event (1 – 10 officers required); \$100.00 for a Category 2 event (11 – 25 officers required); \$150.00 for a Category 3 event (26 – 75 officers required); and \$200.00 for a Category 4 event (76 or greater officers required).

SECTION 3. Section 19-454 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

The chief of police is authorized to issue permits for run, walk or cycling events held on city streets under the following conditions:

- (a) The permit holder shall provide traffic control devices in compliance with the requirements of section 19-66 of the City Code and provide sufficient traffic control personnel as determined by the chief of police or his designated representative to

adequately safeguard the safety of event participants and the general public. Traffic control personnel shall be limited to the furthest extent practicable to City of San Antonio uniformed police officers, and may include, with approval of the chief of police, other uniformed, certified peace officers knowledgeable of traffic control laws, depending on the length and type of the event. The permit holder or his authorized representative shall obtain approval of the traffic control plan described above by the police chief or his designated representative prior to the date of the event. The permit holder shall bear all costs relating to traffic control devices and any on-duty and overtime police required for the event.

(b) Prior to the date of the event, the permit holder shall submit to the city clerk a certificate of insurance showing commercial, general liability coverage, including premises operations, independent contractors, personal injury and contractual liability at a combined single limit of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) per occurrence or with approval of the risk manager according to identified risks involved with the event. The City of San Antonio shall be named as additional insured and provided with at least thirty (30) days advanced notice of cancellation or material alteration of the insurance policy.

(c) Run, walk and cycling events held in whole or in part in the downtown area, as that term is defined in section 4-4 of the Code, shall be limited to Saturdays and Sundays only and must be completed by 9:00 a.m. on Saturdays and 9:30 a.m. on Sundays unless approved by the city council by separate ordinance.

SECTION 4. The City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended to add Section 33-401, which shall provide, in its entirety, as follows:

The following fees are hereby established:

- (1) Inspection of vehicle . . . \$ 25.00

- (3) City chauffeur's license . . . 10.00
- (4) Renewal of city chauffeur's license . . . 10.00

- (7) "Carriage Route/Time Exception" permit . . . 25.00
- (8) Replacement of lost license . . . 15.00
- (9) Permit transfers . . . 25.00
- (10) Driver transfers from one holder to another . . . 5.00
- (11) Vehicle substitution or replacement . . . 25.00
- (12) Late permit payment . . . 25.00

SECTION 5. Section 33-527 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

- (2) Driver Permit . . . 10.00

- (6) Driver Transfers from One Holder to Another . . . 10.00
- (7) Supplemental Permits (5 days) . . . 50.00
(including airport operating permit)

- (10) * Vehicle Permit (per vehicle/per year) . . . 400.00
- (11) Late Permit Payment . . . 25.00
- (12) Re-inspection . . . 25.00

All fees are due upon request of service and non-refundable.

*Fees for each vehicle authorized by the operating permit may be paid in four (4) equal installments which are due in advance on the first business day of January, April, July, and October of each year.

SECTION 6. Section 33-620 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

The following fees are hereby established:

- (1) Inspection of vehicle . . . \$ 25.00
- (2) Driver permit . . . 10.00
- (3) Renewal of driver permit . . . 10.00
- (4) Replacement of lost driver permit . . . 15.00
- (5) Operating permit transfers (per vehicle) . . . 25.00
- (6) Driver transfers from one holder to another . . . 10.00
- (7) Supplemental permits (per application) . . . 25.00
- (8) Application fee . . . 100.00
- (9) Vehicle permit . . . 100.00
- (10) Service area exception permit (per application) . . . 25.00
- (11) Late permit payment . . . 25.00
- (12) Re-inspection . . . 25.00

All fees are due upon request of service and are non-refundable.

All fees are due upon request of service and non-refundable.

* Fees for each vehicle authorized by the operating permit may be paid in four (4) equal installments which are due in advance on the first business day of January, April, July, and October of each year.

SECTION 8. Section 33-933 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:



All fees are due upon request of service and are non-refundable.

* Fees for each vehicle authorized by the operating permit may be paid in four (4) equal installments which are due in advance on the first business day of January, April, July, and October of each year.

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall take effect October 1, 2005.


