

AN ORDINANCE 101427

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEM IN CONNECTION WITH ITS COMMUNITY EDUCATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION PROGRAM KNOWN AS GOLF FORE SA, ACCEPTING A \$100,000.00 GRANT FOR USE IN ESTABLISHING WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAMS, UPGRADES, MONITORING AND EDUCATION AT SIX SAN ANTONIO GOLF COURSES, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.

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WHEREAS, San Antonio Water System (SAWS) has proposed funding to the Parks and Recreation Department to expand the SAWS Golf Fore SA Program (the Program); and

WHEREAS, the Program involves community education and outreach to increase the availability of public information regarding sound principles of golf course environmental management practices; and

WHEREAS, SAWS will provide \$100,000.00 to retrofit six golf course facilities with water saving devices, and to install upgrades and irrigation system improvements at Cedar Creek Golf Course and Brackenridge Golf Course; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 from the San Antonio Water System (SAWS) in connection with the San Antonio Water System Community Education and Environmental Conservation Program, known as the Golf Fore SA Program, at six San Antonio Golf Courses. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with SAWS in connection therewith. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto in substantially final form as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. During the fifteen month term of the program, \$100,000 will be paid to the city by SAWS. As these funds are received they will be deposited in to Fund 29090000, Golf Course Operating and Maintenance, General Ledger 6301120, Recovery of current year's expenses, Cost Center 2654010004.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$100,000.00 to be received by the City from SAWS is hereby appropriated, and City staff is authorized to expend these funds for water conservation programs, upgrades, monitoring and education according to the terms of the agreement.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on and after October 2, 2005.
