

AN ORDINANCE 101441

AUTHORIZING A ONE YEAR EXTENSION OF THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH STERLING'S PUBLIC SAFETY, INC., FOR A UNIFORM COMMISSARY SYSTEM, FROM OCTOBER 1, 2005 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2006, AND PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT TO REQUIRE AVAILABILITY OF ADDITIONAL UNIFORM ITEMS.

WHEREAS, by way of Ordinance No. 97878, passed and approved on June 26, 2003, the City entered into a professional services contract with Sterling's Public Safety, Inc. for a uniform commissary system for the San Antonio Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, said contract will terminate on September 30, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Fire Department wishes to extend the term of the contract through September 30, 2006, at no increase in cost per annum to the City; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Fire Department wishes to negotiate an amendment to the existing contract requiring Sterling's Public Safety, Inc. to include additional uniform clothing selections to be made available through the Commissary; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The professional services contract with Sterling's Public Safety, Inc., authorized through Ordinance No. 97878, passed and approved on June 26, 2003, is hereby extended through September 30, 2006 and amended to provide additional uniform clothing selections as agreed to be available through the Commissary. A copy of the One Year Extension and Amendments to the Commissary System Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment I. The terms of said Extension and Amendment are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 2005.
