

AN ORDINANCE 100296

**ACCEPTING THE OFFER SUBMITTED BY GRAYBAR ELECTRIC COMPANY, THROUGH U.S. COMMUNITIES GOVERNMENT PURCHASING ALLIANCE, TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES DEPARTMENT WITH AN ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR TELECOMMUNICATION SUPPLIES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$280,414.07.**

**WHEREAS**, on February 12, 2004, through ordinance 98797, the City of San Antonio ("City") entered into an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance ("U.S. Communities"), which allows the City to utilize contracts for goods and services procured by its participating member entities; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Los Angeles, a participating member of U.S. Communities, awarded a contract for telecommunication supplies to Graybar Electric Company for a period of two years, effective January 1, 2005, with two one-year options to extend; and

**WHEREAS**, U.S. Communities makes this contract available to the City to utilize; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract will provide the City's Information Technology Services Department with an annual contract for telecommunication supplies for an estimated annual cost of \$280,414.07; and

**WHEREAS**, the telecommunication supplies will include cabling and related hardware used for computer network and communication systems throughout City facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, this procurement satisfies Texas laws on competitive bidding; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City is hereby authorized to utilize the purchasing contract awarded by the County of Los Angeles to Graybar Electric Company, utilizing the U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance, to provide the City of San Antonio Information Technology Services Department with an annual contract for telecommunication supplies for an estimated annual cost of \$280,414.07. A copy of the contract between Graybar Electric Company and Los Angeles County, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

**SECTION 2.** Funding will not be expended by this ordinance. All expenditures will be in accordance with the 2004-2005 budget approved by City Council.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2005.
