

AN ORDINANCE 101516

APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 10:00 A.M. NEAR THE BRACKENRIDGE PARK AREA IN CONNECTION WITH THE VITAL ALLIANCE 5K RUN BEING HELD ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2005, SPONSORED BY THE VITAL ALLIANCE.

WHEREAS, Vital Alliance has requested the approval of a parade permit to hold its “Vital Alliance 5k Run” on Saturday, October 15, 2005 from 8:00 a. m. until 10:00 a. m; and

WHEREAS Vital Alliance has requested closure of certain streets near the Brackenridge Park area, as listed in the above referenced permit; **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by **Vital Alliance** to hold its “Vital Alliance 5K Run” on Saturday, October 15, 2005 from 8:00 a. m, until 10:00, is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity. City staff is authorized to close City of San Antonio streets listed in the parade permit route listed below, and to take reasonable and necessary steps to implement this ordinance:

Route

Start on Zoo Walkway;
North on Walkway to Brackenridge;
South on Brackenridge to Tuleta;
East on Tuleta to Avenue B;
South on Avenue B to Mulberry; and
Return on same route.

SECTION 2. Funds in the amount of \$25.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 entitled “General Fund”, Internal Order Number 223000000082, entitled “TRFC ENG- DES/REV”, General Ledger 4408100 entitled “Street-Barricade Fees” when received.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. **Vital Alliance** shall be responsible for the following: 1) fulfilling all insurance requirements, paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 2) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San

Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 3) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 4) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 6. Vital Alliance shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage if passed by eight or more votes otherwise this ordinance shall become effective on October 16, 2005.


