AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE "AGREEMENT FOR THE INSTALLATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS WITHIN A MUNICIPALITY" BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 93650, TO ADD FOUR ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC SIGNAL INTERSECTIONS AND INCREASE THE TOTAL MAXIMUM REIMBURSABLE AMOUNT TO BE RECEIVED FROM TXDOT.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City of San Antonio (City) have negotiated and entered into an agreement for the installation and reimbursement for the operation and maintenance of traffic signals within a municipality which was approved by Ordinance 93650; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated Supplemental Agreement I which amends the existing agreement to increase from 19 to 23 interchange signals and by increasing the total maximum reimbursable amount paid by TxDOT to the City from \$42,660.89 to \$51,642.13 per year as currently authorized.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Agreement for the Installation and Reimbursement for the Operation and Maintenance of Traffic Signals within a Municipality is amended as set out in the attached Supplemental Agreement No. 1. The City Manager or his/her designee is hereby authorized to execute the Supplemental Agreement. A copy of said Supplemental Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. Funds in the amount of \$51,642.13 are to be deposited into Fund 11001000, General Fund; Internal Order 233000000158, Traffic Recovery of Current Year Expenses; General Ledger 6301121, Recovery of Current Year Expenses; when they are received from TxDOT.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective on October 16, 2005.


