

AN ORDINANCE 101579

**APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 3:00 P.M. IN CONNECTION WITH THE VETERAN'S DAY PARADE TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2005, SPONSORED BY THE U.S. MILITARY VETERAN'S PARADE ASSOCIATION.**

**WHEREAS, the U. S. Military Veterans Parade Association** has requested the approval of a parade permit to hold the "Veterans Parade" on Saturday, November 5, 2005 from 10:00 a. m. until 3:00 p. m., a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**; and

**WHEREAS, the U. S. Military Veterans Parade Association** has requested closure of certain streets in the Milam Park area, as listed in the above referenced permit; **NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The parade permit requested by **U. S. Military Veterans Parade Association** to hold the "Veteran's Parade" on Saturday, November 5, 2005 from 10:00 a. m. until 3:00 p. m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity. City staff is authorized to close City of San Antonio streets listed in the parade permit route (**Exhibit A**), and to take reasonable and necessary steps to implement this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** Funds in the amount of \$25.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund", Internal Order Number 223000000163 entitled TRAFFIC - PARADE/BLOCK PARTY BARRICADE, General Ledger 4401270 entitled Svc Charge - Street Closures and Events when received.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** The **U. S. Military Veterans Parade Association** shall be responsible for the following: 1) fulfilling all insurance requirements, paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 2) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 3) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 4) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 5.** The **U. S. Military Veterans Parade Association** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall become effective on October 30, 2005.


