

AN ORDINANCE 2006-03-02-0302

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR TAX INCREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE NUMBER ELEVEN, CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS AND SAN ANTONIO HOUSING AUTHORITY (SAHA) FOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO LABOR AND LEIGH STREET AND THE INCORPORATION OF A HISTORICAL MARKER AT THE FORMER FIRST BAPTIST SETTLEMENT SITE IN SUPPORT OF THE VICTORIA COMMONS DEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio recognizes the importance of its continued role in economic development; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Tax Increment Financing Act, Texas Tax Code, Chapter 311 (the "Act"), the City of San Antonio, Texas (the "City") created Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number Eleven, City of San Antonio, Texas (the "Zone"), created a Board of Directors for the Zone (the "Board") and authorized the Board to exercise all the rights, powers, and duties as provided to such boards under the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board continues to support the City in development activities for the Inner City Revitalization Project and actively participates in planning and identifying potential Zone projects; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2006, the Board approved the proposed Agreement and recommended to the City that the City enter into the proposed Agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the execution of this agreement with the board and San Antonio Housing Authority (SAHA) for infrastructure improvements to Labor and Leigh Streets as well as the incorporation of a Historical Marker at the former first Baptist Settlement site, in support of the Victoria Commons Development Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; **NOW, THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized and directed to execute the Development Agreement ("Agreement") with the Board of Directors for Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number Eleven, City of San Antonio ("Board") and San Antonio Housing Authority (SAHA), attached and incorporated into this Ordinance for all purposes as Exhibit 1. The terms of said Agreement are approved.


SECTION 2. Approval and execution of this Agreement does not have an immediate fiscal impact. The previous Ordinance approving the amendments of the Final Project Plan and Final Financing Plan authorized the City, to the extent that such funds are available, to pay SAHA, LLC up to a maximum total payment of \$3,362,169.00 beginning in Fiscal Year 2007 and

extending through September 30, 2015, as compensation for the construction of public infrastructure improvements on for infrastructure improvements to Labor and Leigh Streets as well as the incorporation of a Historical Marker at the former first Baptist Settlement site, in support of the Victoria Commons Development Project, as authorized by and pursuant to the Tax Increment Financing Act (Chapter 311 of the Texas Tax Code). Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number Eleven, City of San Antonio has a termination date of September 30, 2015, unless otherwise terminated earlier as authorized or permitted by law.

SECTION 3. The statements set forth in the recitals of this Ordinance are true and correct, and are incorporated as a part of this Ordinance.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on the tenth (10th) day after passage.


