

AN ORDINANCE **2006-03-02-0277**

CLARIFYING THE EX OFFICIO STATUS OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF DIRECTORS FOR TAX INCREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE NUMBERS NINE (HOUSTON STREET) AND ELEVEN (INNER CITY), CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Tax Increment Financing Act, Texas Tax Code, Chapter 311 (the "Act"), the City of San Antonio, Texas (the "City") created Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Numbers Nine (the "Houston Street TIRZ") in 1999 and Eleven (the "Inner City TIRZ") in 2000, and created Boards of Directors for the zones (the "Boards"); and

WHEREAS, the City, in making appointments to the Boards, appointed the City Council members in whose districts the TIRZ are located and Directors of City Departments; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Roger Flores (District 1) in whose District the Houston Street TIRZ and Inner City TIRZ are located, and Councilmembers Sheila McNeil (District 2) and Councilmember Patti Radle (District 5), in whose Districts the Inner City TIRZ is also located, are members of the TIRZ in which their Districts lie; and

WHEREAS, the City's Finance Director and the Director of the Department responsible for the management of the TIF Program, currently the Neighborhood Action Department, have been appointed to the Houston Street TIRZ, and the Finance Director has been appointed to the Inner City TIRZ; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to clarify that the appointments of these individuals were intended to be in an ex officio capacity, meaning that the individual holding the office of City Councilmember or respective Department Director is a full voting member of the board during the time they hold the office of City Council member or respective Department Director; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Councilmember Roger Flores (District 1) is an ex officio member of the Houston Street and Inner City TIRZ Boards of Directors, and Councilmember Sheila McNeil (District 2) and Councilmember Patti Radle (District 5) are ex officio members of the Inner City TIRZ, for the duration of their terms of office as City Council members.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is an ex officio member of the Houston Street and Inner City TIRZ Boards of Directors, and the Director of the Department responsible for the management of the TIF Program, currently the Neighborhood Action Department, is an ex officio member of the Inner City TIRZ Board of Directors.

SECTION 3. The statements set forth in the recitals of this Ordinance are true and correct, and are incorporated as a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this Ordinance or application of any provision of this Ordinance to any circumstance shall be held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application of the remainder of this Ordinance to other circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and this Ordinance would have been enacted without such invalid provision.


