

AN ORDINANCE 2006-02-09-0183

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ACCUMULATED DONATIONS TO THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$21,575.00 FROM INDEPENDENT INSURANCE AGENT OF SAN ANTONIO (\$600), LAS PALAPAS ENTERPRISES (\$200), WAL-MART FOUNDATION (\$10,125), SECURITY SERVICE FEDERAL CREDIT UNION (\$50), SAM'S CLUB FOUNDATION (\$5,500), SAN ANTONIO PROFESSIONAL FIREFIGHTERS ASSOCIATION (\$1,000), SAN ANTONIO TELECOMMUNICATIONS EMPLOYEE GOLF ASSOCIATION (\$3500), HOLT COMPANY OF TEXAS (\$500), AND STATE FARM INSURANCE (\$100).

WHEREAS, several business entities have offered to donate monies to support San Antonio Fire Department education programs; and

WHEREAS, Independent Insurance Agent of San Antonio wishes to donate \$600.00; Las Palapas Enterprises wishes to donate \$200.00; Wal-Mart Foundation wishes to donate \$10,125.00; Security Service Federal Credit Union wishes to donate \$50.00; Sam's Club Foundation wishes to donate \$5,500.00; San Antonio Professional Firefighters Association wishes to donate \$1,000.00; San Antonio Telecommunications Employee Golf Association wishes to donate \$3500.00; Holt Company of Texas wishes to donate \$500.00; and State Farm Insurance wishes to donate \$100.00; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the donations is \$21,575.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept accumulated donations to the San Antonio Fire Department in the total amount of \$21,575.00 from the following business entities: Independent Insurance Agent of San Antonio (\$600), Las Palapas Enterprises (\$200), Wal-Mart Foundation (\$10,125), Security Service Federal Credit Union (\$50), Sam's Club Foundation (\$5,500), San Antonio Professional Firefighters Association

(\$1,000), San Antonio Telecommunications Employee Golf Association (\$3500), Holt Company of Texas (\$500), and State Farm Insurance (\$100).

SECTION 2. These donations are to be deposited into Fund 29609000 (Fire Prevention Week Trust Fund), Internal Order 22000000000018 (Contributions from the Private Sector), General Ledger 4502220 (Contributions Private Donors Restricted).

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
