

AN ORDINANCE

101597

AUTHORIZING ONE-TIME FUNDING IN FY 2006 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000.00 TO SOLAR SAN ANTONIO, A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, IN CONSIDERTION FOR AND IN SUPPORT OF THE ENERGY SMART SCHOOLS CONFERENCE, A SOLAR ENERGY OUTREACH EFFORT; AND PROVIDING PAYMENT.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Payment in the sum of \$15,000.00 is hereby approved to Solar San Antonio, to assist that non-profit organization with energy education to be provided during the annual Energy Smart Schools Conference; and, in consideration for the City's assistance, Solar San Antonio will continue its public outreach efforts to bring about the widespread use of solar and other renewable and sustainable energy.

SECTION 2. In further consideration for Solar San Antonio's efforts, City staff will assist them in obtaining value pricing for the venue, catering, and other conference needs, as well as providing in-kind services such as printing. The funding consideration will be paid, upon presentation of receipts or other suitable documentation evidencing appropriate expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00. The contract, appended hereto and incorporated herein verbatim for all purposes in substantial form, as Attachment A, may be further negotiated as described below, if necessary, between the City of San Antonio and Solar San Antonio; and, the City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute it upon completion of negotiations.


SECTION 3. The following financial adjustments are authorized as may be necessary to effect this Ordinance:

- (a) Funds are available as part of the carry forward budget in Fund 11001000, Fund Center 800243000, General Ledger 5203050.
- (b) Payment of funds not to exceed \$15,000.00 is authorized to Solar San Antonio and should be encumbered upon issuance of a purchase order.
- (c) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The authority granted by this Ordinance shall endure for forty-five (45) days commencing from the action date on this Ordinance, November 3, 2005. During that time, the parties shall have opportunity to negotiate and execute an agreement in comporment with the substantial format appended as Attachment A. Any adjustments or changes to the substantial draft must be approved by the Office of the City Attorney. If an agreement is not executed within such time frame, the authority granted herein shall expire.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect on November 13, 2005.
