

AN ORDINANCE **101732**

**ACCEPTING A JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$446,918.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, FOR A CHILD WELFARE STRATEGIC ALLIANCE PROGRAM, A CITY/COUNTY PROJECT ADDRESSING CHILD ABUSE, FOR A GRANT PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2005, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2009; APPROVING A BUDGET; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND ESTABLISHING A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.**

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**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinance No. 100636, passed and approved on March 31, 2005, Bexar County and the City of San Antonio submitted a joint application to the U.S. Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance for Justice Assistance Grant Program funds in the amount of \$1,117,297.00 that would be used to support the Child Welfare Strategic Alliance Program, a City/County project addressing child abuse; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance has offered grant funds in the aforementioned amount; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's portion of the funds amounts to \$446,918.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant period is October 1, 2005, through September 30, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of said grant requires no matching contribution on the part of the City;  
**NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept, from the U.S. Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance, Justice Assistance Grant Program funds in the amount of \$446,918.00 that would be used to support the Child Welfare Strategic Alliance Program, a City/County project addressing child abuse, for the grant period October 1, 2005,

through September 30, 2009. The City Manager, or her designee, is also authorized to execute any and all documentation necessary to effect said acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Fund No. 26028000, General Ledger Number 4501100, and Internal Order No. 117000000062 (2005 JAG Grant) has been established in SAP for the above said grant, and the budget and personnel complement affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes are approved.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP fund numbers and internal orders as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


