AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE LOW BID SUBMITTED BY MED-ENG SYSTEMS TO PROVIDE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH BOMB SUITS AND HELMETS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$35,460.00, FROM THE 2004 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT FUND.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with bomb suits and helmets; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by Med-Eng Systems for a total cost of \$35,460.00; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Med-Eng Systems to provide the City of San Police Department with bomb suits and helmets for a total cost of \$35,460.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit A is the bid and bid tabulation sheet.


SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$35,460.00 is approved for purchase of bomb suits and helmets for the City of San Antonio Police Department from Med-Eng Systems as appropriated in existing SAP Fund 26065000, entitled "2004 UASI Emergency Management".

SECTION 3. The amount of \$35,460.00 will be encumbered upon issuance of a purchase order made payable to Med-Eng Systems from SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order No. 117000000051, and GL Account # 5701060 entitled "M & E Modified".

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or her designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect November 27, 2005.
