

AN ORDINANCE **101755**

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,614,579.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE OFFICE OF DOMESTIC PREPAREDNESS, WHICH WILL BE USED TO ASSIST THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH HOMELAND SECURITY READINESS OVER THE NEXT THREE TO FIVE YEARS THROUGH TRAINING, DRILLS, PLANNING, EQUIPMENT, AND PHARMACEUTICALS, FOR THE GRANT PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2004, TO DECEMBER 30, 2006.

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WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has grant funds available that may be used for homeland security readiness over the next three to five years; and

WHEREAS, the DHS has offered the City of San Antonio grant funds in the amount of \$4,614,579.00; and

WHEREAS, these funds will used for planning, training, and the purchase of equipment and pharmaceuticals for the grant period of October 1, 2004, through December 30, 2006; and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in the amount of \$4,614,579.00 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security that will be used for homeland security readiness over the next three to five years during the grant period of October 1, 2004, through December 30, 2006. The City Manager, or her designee, is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effect said acceptance.

SECTION 2. SAP Fund No. 26065000 and the following fund centers and internal order numbers are hereby designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of this program.



SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


