

AN ORDINANCE 101861

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A SAM'S CLUB LITERACY GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,750.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF TUTORS TO ASSIST STUDENTS AT THE COMMUNITY FAMILY RESOURCE AND LEARNING CENTERS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006; AND ADOPTING AN FY 2006 PROGRAM BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, the City's Community Family Resource and Learning Centers (CFRLCs) provide free educational opportunities and related services to enable individuals to enhance their ability to read, write and converse at levels of proficiency necessary to function on the job and in society;

WHEREAS, students have low literacy levels in reading and writing, and minimal or no English skills in English-as-a-Second Language (ESL) classes; and

WHEREAS, Sam's Club has approached and provided a \$1,750.00 Literacy Grant to the City's CFRLCs for the provision of tutors; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the acceptance of such funds and adopt a program budget; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives, is authorized to accept a literacy grant award of \$1,750.00 from the Sam's Club to provide tutors to assist students at the Community Family Resource and Learning Centers. A copy of the award letter is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. SAP Fund No. 26012000, entitled "Miscellaneous Agencies", Internal Order No. 138000000437, "2006 Sam's Club Literacy Program" and General Ledger No. 4502220 are hereby designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transaction in this program and the sum of \$1,750.00 is appropriated in said fund. The budget, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II, is adopted.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, an Assistant City Manager or an Assistant to the City Manager, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP internal orders and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective on and after December 25, 2005.
