

AN ORDINANCE 2006-01-05-38

AUTHORIZING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$510,000.00 THROUGH THE FY 2006 ANNUAL TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION PROGRAM FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT FOUR INTERSECTIONS IN COUNCIL DISTRICTS 3, 4, 8 AND 10, AND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00 THROUGH THE ANNUAL TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION AND UPGRADE PROGRAM FOR UPGRADES TO EXISTING TRAFFIC SIGNALS LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE CITY, FOR A TOTAL ORDINANCE AMOUNT OF \$760,000.00 FUNDED FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS RESERVE FUND AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Funds in the amount of \$510,000.00 are hereby authorized payable for the installation of traffic signals at four intersections located in Council Districts 3, 4, 8 and 10. Funds in the amount of \$250,000.00 are also authorized payable for upgrades to existing traffic signals and systems deemed necessary in order to bring these signals up to current City of San Antonio design standards.

SECTION 2. The total Ordinance amount of \$760,000.00 is funded from the Capital Improvements Reserve Fund, subject to the financial adjustments listed immediately below.

SECTION 3. The following financial adjustments are hereby authorized to effect this Ordinance:

- a. The amount of \$760,000.00 is appropriated in Fund 29027000, Special Revenue Reserve Fund, SAP GL account 6102100 - Interfund Transfers Out, entitled Transfer to 23-00491-90-XX. The amount of \$760,000.00 is authorized to be transferred to SAP fund 40099000.
- b. The amount of \$760,000.00 in Fund 4009900, Project Definition 23-00491 FY 2005-2006 Signal Installation and Signal Upgrade Program, WBS element 23-00491-05-02-01 is authorized to be encumbered and made payable for construction costs.
- c. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's

designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective on January 15, 2006.


