

AN ORDINANCE 2006-01-05-18

**AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF FOUR INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES TO PROVIDE FOR STORAGE OF EMERGENCY HEALTH SERVICES EQUIPMENT AND MATERIAL AT VARIOUS SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT FACILITIES FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2006 AND ENDING AUGUST 31, 2006, FOR A FEE OF \$10,000.00.**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of State Health Services wishes to enter into four interlocal agreements with the City of San Antonio to provide for storage of emergency health services equipment and material at various San Antonio Police Department facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, said agreements commence on January 1, 2006, and end on August 31, 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of State Health Services will pay a fee of \$10,000.00 for said services; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designated representative, is hereby authorized to execute four interlocal agreements with the Texas Department of State Health Services to provide for storage of emergency health services equipment and material at various San Antonio Police Department facilities for the period commencing January 1, 2006, and ending August 31, 2006, for a fee of \$10,000.00.


**SECTION 2.** The aforementioned agreements shall be maintained by the San Antonio Police Department. Unless required by law, said agreements shall not be disclosed to the public. The City Council hereby finds that disclosure of such information would compromise public security.

**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount of \$10,000.00 are to be deposited in Fund 11001000 (General Fund), Internal Order 217000000103 (Homeland Security Equipment & Material), General Ledger 4401110 (Lease -- Rental of City Buildings).

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the COSA. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purposes of this ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
