

AN ORDINANCE 2006-01-05-17

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 101074 BY CHANGING THE DESIGNATED TERMS OF MAYOR PRO TEM OF THE CITY COUNCIL DURING THE 2005-2007 TERM.

WHEREAS, Section 9 of the Charter of the City of San Antonio provides, in part, for a Mayor Pro Tem to act as Mayor during the absence or disability of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, a tradition has been established of rotating the Mayor Pro Tem position among all of the members of the Council, other than the Mayor, during the two-year City Council term; and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2005, by Ordinance No. 101074, the City Council approved a schedule designating the Mayor Pro Tem through the two year term of this City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to change the designated dates for Councilmembers Elena Guajardo and Kevin Wolff to serve as Mayor Pro Tem and to permit future exchanges of terms as Mayor Pro Tem to occur by the filing of a written memorandum with the Office of the City Clerk from the Mayor or the affected Councilmembers, without the necessity of an amending Ordinance; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 101074 is amended to switch the designation of Councilmembers Elena Guajardo and Kevin Wolff as Mayor Pro Tem as follows:

Councilmember Kevin Wolff is designated Mayor Pro Tem of the City of San Antonio to serve from November 14, 2005 through January 24, 2006.

Councilmember Elena Guajardo is designated Mayor Pro Tem of the City of San Antonio to serve from January 25, 2006 through April 6, 2006.

SECTION 2. All actions taken by Councilmember Kevin Wolff in his capacity as Mayor Pro Tem from the date he was properly sworn in as Mayor Pro Tem, November 11, 2005, to date are ratified.

SECTION 3. Future exchanges of designated terms as Mayor Pro Tem may occur by filing a written memorandum with the Office of the City Clerk from the Mayor or the affected City Councilmembers, without the necessity of an amending Ordinance authorizing the exchange, provided the Mayor Pro Tem is qualified before acting in such capacity.

SECTION 4. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 101074 is revised in its entirety to read as follows:

“**SECTION 3.** Should a vacancy in the position of a Councilmember occur during the 2005-2007 Council term, the person appointed to fill the remainder of that vacant position shall assume the vacated Councilmember’s designated term as Mayor Pro Tem.”

SECTION 5. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 101074 shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise said ordinance shall take effect on the tenth (10th) day after passage.


