

AN ORDINANCE

RENAMING A SECTION OF WATSON ROAD LOCATED BETWEEN HIGHWAY 16 AND APPROXIMATELY 120 FEET EAST OF APPLEWHITE ROAD TO LONE STAR PASS AND WAIVING PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY CITY CODE FOR RENAMING CITY STREETS, AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN ROLAND GUTIERREZ, DISTRICT 3.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. City Code procedures for renaming streets are waived for this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The street currently named "Watson Road" located between Highway 16 and approximately 120 feet east of "Applewhite Road" is hereby renamed "Lone Star Pass."

SECTION 3. The fee of \$250 received from Toyota Manufacturing of Texas is to be deposited into Fund 11001000, General Fund, Internal Order 229000000000, LAND DEVELOPMENT, General Ledger 4406775, Svc Charge Street Name Change Application Process.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. City Staff are directed to erect appropriate signage.



RE: Street name change for a section of Watson Road to Lone Star Pass


DATE: January 12, 2006

Your support is requested to direct the Department of Development Services to hold a public hearing and change the name for a section of Watson Road, from Hwy 16 to east of Applewhite Road, to Lone Star Pass by January 26, 2006. This action will suspend the 45 day notification required in the City of San Antonio ordinance for street name changes. Bexar County initiated this street name change last year and sent notices to property owners indicating the street name change from Watson Road to Lone Star Pass. On December 20, 2005, Bexar County passed a resolution in favor of changing the street name to Lone Star Pass. Thank you for your consideration.






