

AN ORDINANCE 2006 - 01 - 26 - 0122

**RATIFYING PURCHASES FROM GLAXOSMITHKLINE, ITEMS 1, 2 AND 3; MERCK & CO., INC., ITEMS 4, 5, AND 6; CT INTERNATIONAL, ITEM 7; AND SANOFI-PASTEUR, INC., ITEMS 8, 9 AND 10, UTILIZING THE STATE OF TEXAS CONTRACT, FOR A ONE-TIME EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF VACCINES FOR FOREIGN TRAVEL FOR A TOTAL OF \$121,931.20, AND ACCEPTING THE OFFERS FROM GLAXOSMITHKLINE, ITEMS 1-5; MERCK & CO., INC., ITEMS 6-11; SANOFI-PASTEUR, INC., ITEMS 12-19; RICHIE PHARMACAL CO., ITEM 20; AND CT INTERNATIONAL, ITEMS 21-23, UTILIZING THE STATE OF TEXAS CONTRACT, TO PROVIDE THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT WITH VARIOUS TYPES OF VACCINES ON AN ANNUAL BASIS FOR AN ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF \$4,895,417.00, AND ACCEPTING THE OFFER FROM SANOFI-PASTEUR, INC. FOR FLUZONE INFLUENZA VACCINE FOR A TOTAL OF \$495,635.00 FROM THE PUBLIC HEALTH SUPPORT REVENUE FUND.**

**WHEREAS**, offers were submitted by GlaxoSmithKline, Merck & Co., Inc., CT International, and Sanofi-Pasteur, Inc., utilizing the State of Texas Building and Procurement Commission contract, to provide the Health Department with a one-time emergency purchase of various vaccines for foreign travel and other purposes for a total cost of \$121,931.20; and

**WHEREAS**, offers were also submitted by GlaxoSmithKline, Merck & Co., Inc., Sanofi-Pasteur, Inc., Richie Pharmacal Co., and CT International, utilizing the State of Texas Building and Procurement Commission contract, to provide the Health Department with various types of vaccines on an annual basis for an estimated total cost of \$4,895,417.00; and

**WHEREAS**, these purchases meets the requirements under the terms of the State of Texas Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Resolution No. 91-39-53 on September 12, 1991; and

**WHEREAS**, an offer was submitted by Sanofi-Pasteur, Inc. to provide the Health Department with Fluzone influenza vaccine for a total cost of \$495,635.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(2) which provides for a procurement necessary to protect the public health or safety; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The offers submitted by GlaxoSmithKline, Merck & Co., Inc., CT International, and Sanofi-Pasteur, Inc., utilizing the State of Texas Building and Procurement Commission contract, to provide the Health Department with a one-time emergency purchase of various vaccines for foreign travel and other purposes for a total cost of \$121,931.20 are hereby accepted, and said purchases are hereby ratified. The offers submitted by GlaxoSmithKline, Merck & Co., Inc., Sanofi-Pasteur, Inc., Richie Pharmacal Co., and CT International, utilizing the State of Texas Building and Procurement Commission contract, to provide the Health Department with various types of vaccines on an annual basis for an estimated total cost of \$4,895,417.00 are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. The offer submitted by Sanofi-Pasteur, Inc. to provide the Health Department with Fluzone

influenza vaccine for a total cost of \$495,635.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit A are the bid tabulation sheets. Copies of the contracts are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing and General Services Department.

**SECTION 2.** Funds in the amount of \$121,931.20 are available for purchase of vaccines for foreign travel and other purposes as carry forward budget in Fund 29057000, PUBLIC HEALTH SUPPORT REV FUND, Fund Center 360118000, Public Health Support, General Ledger 5304040, Chemicals, Medical and Drugs.

**SECTION 3.** Payment is authorized to the vendors and in the amounts listed below from the funding source identified in Section 2. These amounts should be encumbered with a purchase order.


