

AN ORDINANCE 2006-04-20-0518

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SUB-AWARD AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT SAN ANTONIO PROVIDING UP TO \$122,564.00 IN ORDER FOR THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT TO COLLECT DATA ON DISADVANTAGED WOMEN WITH ABNORMAL CANCER SCREENING RESULTS THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2006; ADOPTING THE PROGRAM BUDGET; AND APPROVING THE PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.

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WHEREAS, the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio (UTHSCSA) National Center of Excellence in Women's Health has been awarded a five year intervention research project through the National Institute of Health to reduce cancer health disparities; and

WHEREAS, this intervention project is directed toward determining the various barriers and issues involved in women seeking cancer care services and completing the prescribed cancer treatment regime; and

WHEREAS, the UTHSCSA, one of nine project grantees, is collaborating with the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District to target Hispanic women with abnormal findings/diagnoses related to breast and cervical cancer; and

WHEREAS, the population for the study will be selected from clients attending the Southwest Branch Public Health Clinic and the Zarzamora Public Health Clinic; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute a sub-award agreement with the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio (UTHSCSA) providing up to \$122,564.00 in order for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District to collect data on disadvantaged women with abnormal cancer screening results through August 31, 2006. A copy of said sub-award agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. SAP Fund No. 26012000, Funds Center 3606820000, Cost Center 3606820001, Internal Order 136000000292 entitled "2005-06 UTHSCSA Patient Navigation Rsrch", is hereby designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions for the project described in Section 1 of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$122,564.00 is hereby appropriated in the above-designated fund. GL Account No. 4501160, and the budget which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.


SECTION 4. The four (4) personnel positions set out in Attachment II are hereby authorized for the activity shown thereon.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on and after April 30, 2006.


