

AN ORDINANCE 2006-04-20-0520

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$947,182.00 FROM THE TEXAS AUTOMOBILE THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY FOR THE GRANT YEAR SEPTEMBER 1, 2006 TO AUGUST 31, 2007; AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BEXAR COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO FUND TWO DEPUTIES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$137,938.00; APPROVING A CASH MATCH OF \$522,762.00 AND AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$1,385,065.00 UPON AWARD AND CONTINGENT ON THE FY07 BUDGET; AND ESTABLISHING A BUDGET AND PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.**

*WHEREAS*, the San Antonio Police Department desires to submit a grant application and accept grant funds from the Texas Automobile Theft Prevention Authority (ATPA) in the amount of \$947,182.00 to be used to fund the San Antonio Police Department's multi-jurisdictional Regional Auto Crimes Team for the period of September 1, 2006 to August 31, 2007; and

*WHEREAS*, the ATPA mission is to lower the automobile theft rate by instituting innovative enforcement and theft prevention techniques; and

*WHEREAS*, the project, Regional Auto Crimes Team (ReACT), continues the San Antonio Police Department's efforts at combating auto theft crimes; and

*WHEREAS*, the task force will be a multi-jurisdictional unit composed of City, County, and State elements as described in the attached Interlocal Agreement; and

*WHEREAS*, the grant funded positions will include the following: one (1) Police Lieutenant; one (1) Police Sergeant; seven (7) Police Detective Investigators; one (1) Administrative Assistant II; one (1) Administrative Assistant I; and two (2) Bexar County Sheriff Detective Investigators; with In-kind positions including one (1) Bexar County Sheriff Sergeant, two (2) Bexar County Sheriff Detective Investigators; one (1) DPS Motor Vehicle Theft & Salvage (MVTS) Investigators; and one (1) National Insurance Crime Bureau Agent; and

**WHEREAS**, the program continues the City Council's policy of seeking intergovernmental financial assistance for City crime prevention and enforcement programs addressing auto crime activity and will enhance the City's efforts in dealing with auto theft and related property crimes by continuing to recover stolen vehicles and other property through intensified enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of the grant funds requires that the City enter into an interlocal agreement with Bexar County Sheriff's Office to fund two deputy positions for an amount not to exceed \$137,938.00; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of the grant funds requires that the City provide in-kind contributions in the amount of \$1,385,065.00 and a cash match in the amount of \$522,762.00; and

**WHEREAS**, other in-kind matches will be provided by Bexar County Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$220,764.00; the Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$79,641.00; and the National Insurance Crime Bureau in the amount of \$50,000.00; all of which total the program budget amount of \$3,205,414.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to and accept grant funds in the amount of \$947,182.00 from the Texas Automobile Theft Prevention Authority (ATPA) which will be used to augment the San Antonio Police Department's efforts in reducing auto theft. A cash match of \$522,762.00 and an in-kind match of \$1,385,065.00 from the City are hereby authorized, upon award of the ATPA grant, in connection with its acceptance. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documentation to effect said acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Fund No. 26031000, entitled "Texas Automobile Theft Authority," Internal Order 11700000074 entitled, "2006-07 Regional Auto Crimes Team" is hereby designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of this grant should funding be awarded, and the sum of \$947,182.00 from ATPA will be appropriated in said fund as set out in the detailed budget affixed hereto, and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I, and is hereby approved.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized, upon award, to enter into the Interlocal Agreement, a copy of which is attached as Attachment III, with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office in an amount not to exceed \$137,938.00 to fund two deputy positions. The terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement are hereby approved upon award.


**SECTION 4.** The sum of \$137,938.00 will be appropriated in the above-designated fund for two (2) deputy positions, and appropriation of a cash match of \$522,762.00 and in-kind match of \$1,385,065.00 upon award of the grant. Upon award and full execution of the Interlocal Agreement, a sum not to exceed \$137,938.00 is hereby authorized to be paid to Bexar County Clerk County Auditor, from and encumbered in the above-designated fund.

**SECTION 5.** A personnel complement, set out in Attachment II, is hereby authorized and approved upon funding.

**SECTION 6.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to award and approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of the passage.
