**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF A CONTRACT WITH SELRICO SERVICES, INC., TO PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY INITIATIVES WITH MEAL PREPARATION AND DELIVERY SERVICES FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE NUTRITION PROGRAM, FOR A TWO-YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2006 FOR AN APPROXIMATE COST OF \$5,008,852.00, FROM ALAMO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS GRANT FUNDS AND THE GENERAL FUND.**

**WHEREAS**, on April 7, 2005, through Ordinance No. 100661, the City Council accepted the best value bid of Selrico Services, Inc. (the "Contract"), to provide the City of San Antonio Community Initiatives Department ("DCI") with meal preparation services in support of the Comprehensive Nutrition Project ("CNP"), administered by DCI's Senior Services Division; and

**WHEREAS**, the Contract provides for a 16 month term, beginning June 1, 2005 and ending September 30, 2006, with the option to renew for one additional two year term, subject to appropriation of funds therefor; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost for this renewal period is approximately \$5,008,852.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City anticipates receiving a grant from the Alamo Area Council of Governments ("AACOG") in partial support of the CNP, which will be supplemented by other funds available to the City in fiscal year 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the City now wishes to extend this Contract for an additional two-year period, to begin on October 1, 2006 and continue through September 30, 2008, subject to receipt of the AACOG grant and appropriation of other funding therefore; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**


**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Purchasing & General Services, is hereby authorized to renew the contract with Selrico Services, Inc. to provide food preparation and delivery services to the City of San Antonio for the CNP for the period from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2008, under the same terms and conditions, at a cost of approximately \$5,008,852.00, subject to receipt of the AACOG grant funds and additional appropriation of funds from the City for fiscal year 2007. Continuation of the contract for fiscal year 2008 is also subject to receipt of AACOG grant funds and additional appropriation of funds from the City for that fiscal period.

**SECTION 2.** Fund 26011000 entitled "Governor's Committee on Aging" and Internal Order 138000000405 entitled "2006 CNP Evidence Based Prevention Demonstration Project", are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction of this contract.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Acting Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or her designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect on May 14, 2006


