

AN ORDINANCE 2006-05-18-0596

APPROVING THE APPOINTMENTS OF GEORGE R. GREEN, NANCY J. EDGAR AND MARISOL FAZ MARTINEZ (CATEGORY: BUSINESS) TO THE ALAMO WORKSOURCE BOARD FOR THE REMAINDER OF UNEXPIRED TERMS TO EXPIRE DECEMBER 31, 2008, DECEMBER 31, 2007 AND DECEMBER 31, 2006, RESPECTIVELY.

WHEREAS, the Alamo WorkSource Board contracts for or operates employment and workforce programs in a twelve county area, including operation of the workforce centers, youth and childcare programs and training partnerships; and

WHEREAS, the Partnership Agreement (the "Agreement") between the Alamo Workforce Development Board (also known as the Alamo WorkSource Board, the "AWB") and the Chief Elected Officials (consisting of eleven rural Area Judges, the chief Bexar County Judge and the Mayor of San Antonio – defined as the "CEOs") of the Alamo Workforce Development Area (the "AWDA") was approved by City Council Ordinance No. 97628 on May 15, 2003; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the principle entities of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, and the Area Judges representing the surrounding eleven (11) rural counties (the "Principles"), must reach consensus on a single slate of individuals recommended for appointment to the AWB; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation for appointment is made by two representatives of each of the Principles (the "Committee of Six"); and

WHEREAS, the Texas Workforce Commission (the "TWC") stipulates that 51% of the board must be represented by the private sector and be balanced geographically to represent the entire twelve county region, by ethnicity and gender; and

WHEREAS, some of the required categories include private sector business, organized labor, education, literacy, community-based organizations, economic development, public assistance, public employment and vocational rehabilitation, among others; and

WHEREAS, the Committee of Six considered nominees for reappointment to the board in various categories for terms set to expire effective December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Committee of Six recommended, at its November 18, 2005 meeting, the appointments of George R. Green, Nancy J. Edgar and Marisol Faz Martinez to the AWB in the *business* category, as reflected in the table of AWB place assignments and terms attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment I; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement also specifies that no recommended appointment to the AWB will be official until it is approved by each of the Principles; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of San Antonio hereby approves the appointments to the Alamo Workforce Development Board, also known as the Alamo WorkSource Board, of George R. Green, Nancy J. Edgar and Marisol Faz Martinez to unexpired terms in the *business* category.

SECTION 2. The terms of each of the appointments in Section 1 shall expire December 31, 2008, December 31, 2007 and December 31, 2006, respectively.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective on the tenth (10th) day after passage.


