

AN ORDINANCE 2006-06-01-0641

DECLARING 1536 SANTIAGO STREET IN DISTRICT 5 AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE TO ROBERT MONTALVO, FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF \$1,200.00, THE CITY'S SHARE BEING \$564.00 AND THE BALANCE GOING TO OTHER TAXING AUTHORITIES

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following properties are declared surplus to the needs of the City of San Antonio: 156 Santiago Street, San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, as more particularly described as Lot 15, Block 1, New City Block 6465.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and her designee are authorized and directed to execute and deliver a deed in favor of Robert Montalvo or his designee and otherwise to do all things necessary or convenient to effectuate transfer of the City's title to the properties.

SECTION 3. The City's portion of funds generated by this ordinance, \$564.00, are to be deposited in Fund 29027000, Special Reserve Fund, Internal Order 224000000010, Sales of Land, General Ledger 4903101, Sales-Land. The remaining \$636.00 is to be deposited into Fund 29027000, General Ledger 2120160, Collections Held in Trust, as follows: Bexar County - \$444.00; SAISD - \$192.00. Payment to the above other taxing authorities is authorized.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. This ordinance becomes effective June 11, 2006.



SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance will declare 1536 Santiago Street in District 5 surplus and authorize its sale to Robert Montalvo, for a total price of \$1,200.00, the City's share of that amount being \$564.00 and the balance going to other taxing authorities.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Department of Asset Management is requesting to declare as surplus and sell a tract of City-owned real property, as shown on Exhibit "A". This property has been held in trust by the City of San Antonio due to a tax foreclosure and is required to be sold in accordance with Ch. 34 of the Texas Tax Code which specifies that the fair market value may be determined by the public advertisement of a sealed bid process. The bid documents issued by the City allows for the City to "select a bid deemed to be in the City's best interest to include the highest and best use of the property, a desirable exchange of property, or the greatest bid amount."

The property was offered through a public notice and a sealed bid process after the completion of an internal canvassing. This unbuildable property is approximately 1,790 square feet in area and is zoned R4 (Residential Single-Family District). Staff accepted a bid for the property from Robert Montalvo on April 24, 2006. For informational purposes, a relative of Robert Montalvo owns an abutting property to the City-owned property at 1536 Santiago Street.

This property will be conveyed by a Deed Without Warranty and the proceeds from the sale of this property will be distributed proportionally to the taxing entities pursuant to Chapter 34 of the Texas Tax Code.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is consistent with the City Code and Ordinances, which require City Council approval for the disposition of any surplus City-owned real property.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City will sell this surplus City-owned real property for the total consideration of \$1,200.00 with the City's portion being \$564.00. The Bexar County's portion will be \$444.00 and the San Antonio Independent School District's portion will be \$192.00. In addition, this property will be returned to the tax rolls where the land and any constructed improvements will again generate tax revenue for all of the taxing entities.

COORDINATION

In compliance with City procedures, this request has been canvassed through interested City departments, public utilities and applicable agencies.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

The City of San Antonio's Planning Commission will consider this request at its regular meeting of 5/24/2006 and its finding will be presented to City Council on 6/1/2006.


