

AN ORDINANCE 2006-06-15-0706

ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF VARIOUS COMPANIES TO PROVIDE THE CITY WITH VARIOUS TYPES OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES ON AN ANNUAL CONTRACT BASIS FOR FY 2006 FOR A COMBINED ESTIMATED COST OF \$477,665.00, INCLUDING: INTERNET TUTORING SERVICES FOR LIBRARY; SUPPLEMENTAL TAXI SERVICES FOR SENIORS; BAGGED PORTLAND AND READY MIX CONCRETE; TRAFFIC SIGNAL STEEL POLES; AND EXTENDED VIEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND PEDESTRIAN LIGHTS.

WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, this group of contracts represents a portion of approximately two hundred and fifty (250) annual contracts that will be brought before City Council throughout the remainder of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, these bids are from various companies to furnish the City with: internet tutoring services for the Library; supplemental taxi services for seniors; bagged Portland and Ready Mix concrete; traffic signal steel poles; and extended view traffic signal and pedestrian lights; and

WHEREAS, Section I of the attachment consists of 2 single source of supply contracts; and

WHEREAS, Section II of the attachment consists of 3 contracts in which awards are recommended to the lowest bidders; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the 2005-2006 budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bids of various companies to furnish the City with: internet tutoring services for Library; supplemental taxi services for seniors; bagged Portland and Ready Mix concrete; traffic signal steel poles; and extended view traffic signal and pedestrian lights are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. The bids and bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$477,665.00 will be encumbered upon issuance of various purchase orders, and payment is authorized to various vendors as identified on the attached bid tabulation sheets. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY 2005-2006 budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect June 25, 2006.

SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

The attached tabulation of bids is hereby submitted for council consideration and action. Annually at this time, bids are requested for various materials, parts and services. This ordinance includes contracts for internet tutoring services for Library; supplemental taxi services for seniors; bagged portland and ready mix concrete; traffic signal steel poles; and extended view LED traffic signal lamps and pedestrian LED's.

Many bids are on a firm, non-escalating basis, while others such as petroleum related items and certain other commodities require escalation of prices during the contract period. Generally, bids reflect small increases over recent prior years, but in many cases reflect decreases.

It is recommended these contracts be approved.

SECTION I: The bids in this section are a single source of supply bids. (2 contracts)


SECTION II: The bids in this section are low bids in which award is recommended to the lowest bidder. (3 contracts)

POLICY ANALYSIS


Annual contracts are an efficient method of securing the best prices through volume purchasing and by reducing large amounts of work related to the bid process. This group of contracts represents a portion of approximately 250 annual contracts that will be brought before City Council throughout the remainder of the fiscal year.

Funds are not expended by this ordinance. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY 2006 budget approved by City Council. The combined estimated total for contracts listed on this ordinance is approximately \$477,665.



Description of Item(s) and Use:

This contract will provide the San Antonio Public Library and the Alamo Area Library System with Live Homework Help online tutoring services. This live one on one tutoring service will be accessible to students who have a current library card. Students can access tutoring services from computers at all Library branches and the Central Library. Access to the one on one live tutoring service will also be available to the 45 member libraries in the Alamo Area Library System. Students can also access the tutoring services remotely from home computers by using a link on the Library's Website. Tutoring services are 20 minute sessions for students in grades 4-12 in core academics such as math, science, social studies and English.
