

AN ORDINANCE 2006-06-29-0808

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,628,364.00 IN SUPPORT OF THE TAXIWAY R EXTENSION, RUNWAY 12R HOLDING BAY EXTENSION, UPDATE TO THE TERMINAL AREA FORECAST, AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE RUNWAY SAFETY ACTION TEAM AT THE SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the City has applied for a grant with the Federal Aviation Administration under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) in support of the Taxiway R Extension Project, the Runway 12R Holding Bay Extension Project, an update to the Terminal Area Forecast, and the development of a Runway Safety Action Team at the San Antonio International Airport, all of which are included as part of the Aviation Department's Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the FAA will offer grant funds for these projects in the amount of \$2,628,364.00; and

WHEREAS, in order to fund this grant, the Federal Aviation Administration must have the accepted, fully executed grant in their possession no later than August 18, 2006; and

WHEREAS, in order to assure proper funding for these projects, it is now necessary to authorize acceptance of the grant; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to accept the AIP Grant from the FAA in support of the Taxiway R Extension Project, the Runway 12R Holding Bay Extension Project, an update to the Terminal Area Forecast, and the development of a Runway Safety Action Team at the San Antonio International Airport, in the amount of \$2,628,364.00, if offered by the FAA.

SECTION 2. The budgets for the grant funded projects, including the City's proportionate share will be established, appropriations authorized, and contracts awarded by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage.


