

AN ORDINANCE 2006-06-29-0800

**AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN AMENDMENT TO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT AWARD FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES WHICH WILL PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$562,260.00 FOR THE STEPS TO A HEALTHIER SAN ANTONIO PROGRAM OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 22, 2005 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 21, 2006; AUTHORIZING A REVISED PROGRAM BUDGET; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AMENDMENTS TO FIVE AGREEMENTS WITH BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM, SAN ANTONIO – BEXAR COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, SAN ANTONIO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY, AND YMCA OF GREATER SAN ANTONIO.**

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**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) issued Funding Opportunity No. 04234 in May 2004, entitled “Steps to a Healthier US: A Community-Focused Initiative to Reduce the Burden of Asthma, Diabetes and Obesity”; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District’s Steps to a Healthier San Antonio (Steps-SA) which had assembled interested community-based partners to collaborate and combat the risk factors of tobacco use, poor nutrition and insufficient physical activity was selected for DHHS funding in September 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, in its second year, Steps-SA is continuing its efforts to reduce the community impact of diabetes, obesity and asthma; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance will provide additional funding for existing Steps-SA agreements with these community based partners and allow for minor changes to be made to line item funds to ensure best usage of available resources; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is authorized to accept an amendment to a Cooperative Agreement award from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services which will provide additional funds in the amount of \$562,260.00 for the Steps to a Healthier San Antonio Program of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District for the period September 22, 2005 through September 21, 2006. A copy of said amendment to the Cooperative Agreement Award is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute amendments to five agreements with Bexar County Hospital District dba University Health System, San Antonio –

Bexar County Metropolitan Planning Organization, San Antonio Independent School District, American Cancer Society, and YMCA of Greater San Antonio. A copy of each said amendment to the professional services agreements is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment III through Attachment VII.

**SECTION 3.** Fund No. 26022000 entitled Dept Of Health & Human Services and Internal Order 136000000285 entitled "Steps to a Healthier US 2005-06", is hereby designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of this project.

**SECTION 4.** The additional sum of \$562,260.00 is hereby appropriated in the above-designated fund, GL 4501100, increasing the total budget to \$2,071,060.00. The revised budget which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all pruposes as Attachment II is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.

**SECTION 5.** Payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$1,435,649.00 are authorized for professional service agreements being developed to collaborate with community partners for the period September 22, 2005 through September 21, 2006. These payments will be made from Fund No. 26022000, Internal Order 136000000285, GL 5201040 Fees to Professional Contractors, on a fee-for-service basis

**SECTION 6.** Payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$17,986.00 are hereby authorized to be paid for rental of facilities needed in connection with a proposed conference. These payments will be made from Fund No. 26022000, Internal Order 136000000285, GL 5206010 Rental of Facilities.

**SECTION 7.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 8.** This ordinance shall be effective on and after July 9, 2006.
