

AN ORDINANCE **97098**

ACCEPTING THE OFFER FROM COMMERCIAL VIDEO SYSTEMS, INC., A QUALIFIED INFORMATION SYSTEMS VENDOR, TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S ALAMODOME WITH A DIGITAL BETA TAPE-EDITING RECORDER FOR A TOTAL SUM OF \$37,050.00.

WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Commercial Video Systems, Inc., to provide the City of San Antonio's Alamodome with a digital beta tape-editing recorder for a total sum of \$37,050.00; and

WHEREAS, the Alamodome requires a digital tape-editing recorder to update and enhance the capabilities of its Video Production department and this purchase will accept all formats of Sony Beta tapes; and

WHEREAS, this equipment will be purchased from Commercial Video Systems, Inc. utilizing the Texas Building and Procurement Commission "QISV" program and the purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the State of Texas Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Resolution No. 91-39-53 on September 12, 1991; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by Commercial Video Systems, Inc., for a total sum of \$37,050.00, to provide the City of San Antonio's Alamodome with a digital beta tape-editing recorder is hereby accepted. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and the offer are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. Funds are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 29-006000 (Miscellaneous Special Revenue, Hotel Motel/Dome Fund) in Index Code 541961 entitled "Machine & Equipment-Other" for \$37,050.00 when a purchase order is issued and made payable to Commercial Video Systems, Inc.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
