

AN ORDINANCE **9 8 8 4 6**

**ACCEPTING THE LOW RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED
BY BRAY MANUFACTURING, INC. TO PROVIDE THE
CITY OF SAN ANTONIO CONVENTION AND VISITORS
BUREAU WITH CONVENTION NAME BADGES AND
ACCESSORIES FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$27,970.00.**

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Convention and Visitors Bureau with name badges and accessories to be utilized by participants attending conventions throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by Advertising Concepts and Safety-Touch & Javithon, Inc. failed to meet the City specifications; and

WHEREAS, Bray Manufacturing, Inc. was the low responsive bidder for a total contract cost of \$27,970.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low, responsive bid of Bray Manufacturing, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Convention and Visitors Bureau with name badges and accessories for a total amount of \$27,970.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bid and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bids of Advertising Concepts and Safety-Touch & Javithon, Inc. failed to meet the City's specifications.

SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$27,970.00 are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 29-005000 (Hotel/Motel Tax Fund) in Index Code 399352 entitled "Binding, Printing & Reproduction" and made payable to Bray Manufacturing, Inc.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect on February 29, 2004.
