

AN ORDINANCE 9 8 8 5 9

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR MILAM PARK IN CONNECTION WITH THE ALL AMERICAN ARMED FORCES PARADE SPONSORED BY THE AMERICAN GI FORUM AND MOPH TO BE HELD FROM 5:30 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, MAY 15, 2004.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the **American GI Forum and MOPH** to hold the "All American Armed Forces Parade" on Saturday, May 15, 2004 beginning at 5:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. is hereby approved. The City Council finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. In order to hold "All American Armed Forces Parade" on Saturday, May 15, 2004 beginning at 5:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m., the temporary closure of portions of the streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

Assembly Area: Avenue E between Third and Brooklyn
Fourth between Alamo and Bonham
McCullough between Alamo and Bonham
Sixth between Alamo and Elm

Route: South on Avenue E to Houston Street
West on Houston Street from Avenue to Alamo
South on Alamo from Houston Street to Commerce
West on Commerce from Alamo to San Saba
North on San Saba from Commerce to Houston Street and disband at Milam Park.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. **American GI Forum and MOPH** shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,

- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 5. American GI Forum and MOPH shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on the 29th day of February 2004.


