

AN ORDINANCE **99207**

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF \$21,782.00 AND \$52,857.00 IN CARRY OVER FUNDING FROM THE HEALTH RESOURCES & SERVICES ADMINISTRATION TO AUGMENT THE ONGOING HEALTHY START INITIATIVE OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD ENDING MAY 31, 2004; AMENDING THE PROJECT BUDGET; AND REVISING THE PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, through the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD), currently provides comprehensive public health services to protect the health of all residents within the jurisdiction of the SAMHD; and

WHEREAS, the SAMHD operates the Healthy Start Initiative, a project that provides extensive outreach, recruitment, case management and health education interventions to women and families in order to reduce the incidence of infant mortality and low birth weights in target communities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 98133, passed and approved on September 11, 2003, authorized the acceptance of \$750,000.00 from the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) for the SAMHD to continue operation of this project for the period June 1, 2003 through May 31, 2004; and

WHEREAS, HRSA is now offering carry over funding of \$21,782.00 and \$52,857.00 from previous years, a total of \$74,639.00, to augment operation of the Healthy Start Initiative for the budget period ending May 31, 2004; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the acceptance of the carry over grant funding, amend the project budget and revise the personnel complement; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to accept the two carry forward grant amounts totaling \$74,639.00 from the Health Resources & Services Administration for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) to augment operation of the Healthy Start Initiative for the budget period ending May 31, 2004. A copy of the HRSA Notice of Grant Award in the amount of \$21,782.00 dated September 26, 2003 is set out in Attachment II and incorporated herein for all purposes. A copy of the HRSA Notice of Grant Award in the amount of \$52,857.00 dated April 13, 2004 is set out in Attachment III and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. Fund 26-022097 entitled "Healthy Start Initiative" has been designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of this project.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$74,639.00 is appropriated in the above fund for the Healthy Start Initiative project and the budget set out in Attachment I is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.

SECTION 4. The personnel complement of the Healthy Start Initiative is hereby revised to reflect one additional position as indicated in Attachment I.

SECTION 5. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.


SECTION 6. Should the grant be in an amount other than that budgeted for, or should the grant contain terms and conditions different than those currently existing, acceptance of the grant, budget and corresponding personnel complement will be subject to subsequent City Council ordinance.


SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective on May 30, 2004.
