AN ORDINANCE            **9 9 2 2 1**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT CASH DONATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,500.00 FROM WAL-MART (\$500.00); SECURITY SERVICE FEDERAL CREDIT UNION (\$4,000.00); AND THE SOUTH TEXAS MERCHANTS ASSOCIATION (\$5,000.00), WHICH WILL BE USED TO SUPPORT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS.**

**WHEREAS**, as a community relations initiative, Wal-Mart desires to donate \$500.00, Security Service Federal Credit Union desire to donate \$4,000.00, and the South Texas Merchants Association desires to donate \$5,000.00 to the City of San Antonio Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds, if approved, will be utilized to support the Fire Department's Public Education Programs which range from the Adopt a School Program to Fire Prevention Week activities; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept donations totaling \$9,500.00 from Wal-Mart (\$500.00); Security Service Federal Credit Union (\$4,000.00), and the South Texas Merchants Association (\$5,000.00) to support the Fire Department's Public Education Programs. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute any and all documentation necessary to effect said acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Funds totaling \$9,500.00 shall be established in Fund 62-022000, Expendable Trust Fund, Fire Prevention Week Trust Fund. Revenue index code 053975, entitled "Contribution from Private Sector" shall be credited upon receipt from Wal-Mart, Security Service Federal Credit Union, and the South Texas Merchants Association.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
