

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR ST. MARY'S CATHOLIC CHURCH (202 N. ST. MARY'S) IN CONNECTION WITH THE EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION SPONSORED BY THE EUCHARISTIC ADORATION OF SAN ANTONIO TO BE HELD FROM 4:15 P.M. TO 5:00 P.M. ON SUNDAY, JUNE 13, 2004.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the **Eucharistic Adoration of San Antonio**, for a parade permit to hold the Eucharistic Procession on Sunday, June 13, 2004 beginning at 4:15 p.m until 4:30 p.m.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

Route for Parade/Run


Assembling in St. Mary's Catholic Church at 202 N. St. Mary's Street, North on St. Mary's to Houston Street (East Traffic Lane), East on Houston Street (Using Southern Sidewalk) to Alamo, South on Alamo (Using Eastern Sidewalk) to Commerce, East on Commerce (Using the Northern Traffic Lane) to 623 E. Commerce, Disbanding at St. Joseph's Catholic Church.

SECTION 3. Eucharistic Adoration of San Antonio shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. Eucharistic Adoration of San Antonio shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the May 30, 2004.
