

AN ORDINANCE 99544

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF UP TO \$34,500.00 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (TDH) TO RENEW SUPPORT OF THE MILK AND DAIRY LABORATORY SAMPLE TESTING PROGRAM OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 2004 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2005; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT; AND ADOPTING THE PROGRAM BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Health (TDH) provides annual financial assistance to the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) to supplement the delivery of comprehensive public health services to protect the health of all residents within the jurisdiction of the District; and

WHEREAS, these services include a variety of activities including the testing of milk samples from local retailers; and

WHEREAS, TDH has now offered support of up to \$34,500.00 through Contract No. 7460020708A 2005, Attachment 01, for the period September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005 to renew support for the Milk and Dairy Laboratory Sample Testing Program of the SAMHD; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the acceptance and execution of the contract and adopt the program budget; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to accept up to \$34,500.00 from TDH to renew support of the Milk and Dairy Laboratory Sample Testing Program of the SAMHD for the period September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute Contract No. 7460020708A 2005 with TDH. A copy of this contract is set out as Attachment II and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. Fund No. 26-016067 entitled "Public Health State Support Project 2004-2005 (State)" has been previously designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of this project. This fund is authorized to be revised in accordance with TDH Contract 7460020708A 2005.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$34,500.00 is hereby appropriated in the above-designated fund and the budget set out in Attachment I is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.

SECTION 4. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Should the contract change be in an amount other than that budgeted for, or should the contract change contain terms and conditions different than those currently existing, acceptance of the contract change, budget and corresponding personnel complement will be subject to subsequent City Council ordinance.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on and after August 22, 2004.


