

AN ORDINANCE 99594

APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE BRACKENRIDGE PARK AREA IN CONNECTION WITH THE CTRC RUN 4 LIFE 5K RUN/WALK BEING HELD ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2004 FROM 7:30 A.M. UNTIL 9:30 A.M.; SPONSORED BY THE CANCER THERAPY RESEARCH CENTER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the **Cancer Therapy Research Center** to hold the "CTRC Run 4 Life 5K Run/Walk" on Saturday, September 11, 2004 beginning at 7:30 a.m. until 9:30 a.m. is hereby approved. The City Council finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. In order to hold "CTRC Run 4 Life 5K Run/Walk" on Saturday, September 11, 2004 beginning at 7:30 a.m. until 9:30 a.m., the temporary closure of portions of the streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

Assembly Area: Zoo Parking Lot to St. Mary's
Route: South on St. Mary's to E. Mulberry
East on E. Mulberry to Red Oak
North on Red Oak to Tuleta
East on Tuleta to Wilderness
South on Wilderness to Brackenridge
North on Parfun Way to Tuleta
East on Tuleta to Brackenridge
South on Brackenridge to Parfun Way
East on Parfun Way to Avenue B
North on Avenue B to Tuleta
West on Tuleta to Brackenridge
Northbound on Brackenridge to Walkway through park
Westbound on Walkway to Tuleta
Enter circle and South on St. Mary's to Zoo parking

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. Cancer Therapy Research Center shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area up after the event is held.


SECTION 5. Cancer Therapy Research Center shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on the 29th day of August 2004.
