

AN ORDINANCE 99702

AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING ADJUSTMENTS TO DISTRICT 5's ONE-TIME PROJECT BUDGETS: REDUCING FUNDS SET ASIDE IN THE FY 2000 DISTRICT 5 ONE-TIME PROJECTS BUDGET FOR THE INMAN CHRISTIAN CENTER CORRIDOR REVITALIZATION PROJECT FROM \$95,060.32 TO \$59,010.32; ALLOCATING \$1,550.00 TO VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS – WESTSIDE POST 8936 TO HELP OFFSET COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPLACEMENT OF ONE OF THEIR AIR CONDITIONERS; ALLOCATING \$20,000.00 TO THE GUADALUPE COMMUNITY CENTER TO HELP OFFSET THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THEIR AFTER SCHOOL/SUMMER DANCE AND WELLNESS/NUTRITION PROGRAMS; ALLOCATING \$2,500.00 TO SOUTH TEXAS BUSINESS FUND TO HELP OFFSET THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE DISTRICT 5 IS OPEN FOR BUSINESS – “PROJECT FROM THE ONE STOP BUSINESS SUMMIT”; AND ALLOCATING \$12,000.00 TO THE CENTER FOR JUVENILE MANAGEMENT, INC., TO HELP OFFSET THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH RENOVATING AN EXISTING BUILDING TO BE UTILIZED AS A COMPUTER LABORATORY FOR TRAINING PEOPLE WHO SEEK TECHNICAL LEARNING IN PREPARATION FOR GREATER JOB PLACEMENT OPPORTUNITIES; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILWOMAN PATTI RADLE, DISTRICT 5.

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WHEREAS, City Councilwoman Patti Radle has received various requests from agencies seeking public funds to off-set certain expenses which City Council hereby finds support municipal public purposes; and

WHEREAS, a sufficient balance exists in the District 5 One-Time Project Budgets to support these requests, which balances must now be re-allocated for these purposes; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The requests of the Veterans of Foreign Wars- Westside Post 8936, the Guadalupe Community Center; the South Texas Business Fund, and the Center for Juvenile Management, Inc., which are attached to this ordinance as Exhibit I, are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or a designee, is hereby authorized for a period of sixty (60) from the effective date of this ordinance, to execute agreements with said agencies which set out the terms and conditions for receiving and using public funds. Substantially final copies of these agreements are attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 2 and will be replaced with fully executed agreements upon final execution by the parties.

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SECTION 3: The budget in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in Index Code 666107 entitled "Inman Christian Center Corridor Revitalization" is authorized to be reduced by \$36,050.00.

SECTION 4: Funds in the amount of \$1,550.00 are authorized to be appropriated in Fund 11 (General Fund) in Index Code 615641 entitled "Veterans of Foreign Wars – Westside Post 8936" and made payable to Veterans of Foreign Wars – Westside Post 8936.

SECTION 5: Funds in the amount of \$20,000.00 are authorized to be appropriated in Fund 11 (General Fund) in Index Code 615870 entitled "Guadalupe Community Center" and made payable to the Guadalupe Community Center.

SECTION 6: Funds in the amount of \$2,500.00 are authorized to be appropriated in Fund 11 (General Fund) in Index Code 615633 entitled "South Texas Business Fund" and made payable to the South Texas Business Fund.

SECTION 7: Funds in the amount of \$12,000.00 are authorized to be appropriated in Fund 11 (General Fund) in Index Code 615799 entitled "Center for Juvenile Management" and made payable to the Center for Juvenile Management, Inc.

SECTION 8: The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall take effect on the tenth (10th) day after the date of passage hereof.
