

RESOLUTION NO. 09-04-05

**RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE BOUNDARY
BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE CITY OF KIRBY
INVOLVING APPROXIMATELY 39.8 ACRES SUBJECT TO
APPROVAL OF THE ADJUSTMENT BY THE CITY OF CONVERSE.**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code permits adjacent cities to make mutually agreeable boundary adjustments; and

WHEREAS, the current boundary line between the City of San Antonio and the City of Kirby current dissects lots in several areas.

WHEREAS, the proposed adjustment would resolve potential confusion injurisdiction and delivery of services to the parcels involved; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

SECTION 1. The Planning Commission approves and recommends City Council adopt a municipal boundary adjustment to allow approximately 38.7 acres (currently in the City of San Antonio) to lie within the municipal boundaries of the City of Kirby; and to allow approximately 1.1 acres to be adjusted (from the City of Kirby) to lie within the City of San Antonio as illustrated in Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The City of Kirby shall reimburse the City of San Antonio \$56,495 for road improvements to Old Seguin Road scheduled for repair in 2009.
