

AN ORDINANCE 2007-02-01-0129

WAIVING THE NINETY (90) DAY MAXIMUM TIME PERIOD FOR PUBLIC HEARING ESTABLISHED BY CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI, CITY CODE OF SAN ANTONIO FOR THE RENAMING OF FACILITIES AND STREETS AND AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF DE ZAVALA ROAD BETWEEN BABCOCK AND MAPLEPARK DRIVE TO "BAMBERGER WAY" AND DE ZAVALA ROAD BETWEEN NORTH LOOP 1604 AND NCB 14615, BLK 0, LOT 2 TO "BAMBERGER TRAIL."

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WHEREAS, concerned citizens of the Carriage Hills Neighborhood Association contacted the office of Councilman Art Hall to discuss issues of confusion by emergency response personnel in two segments of De Zavala Road, which is disjointed, and propose a name change as a solution to the problem; and

WHEREAS, Council District 8 requested that the issue be examined due to the number of emergency services needed in the area and the difficulty in locating addresses along these segments of De Zavala Road and expressed support, along with all affected emergency response agencies, of the proposed name changes in the interest of public safety; and

WHEREAS, notice of said proposal was disseminated through public service announcements and postings at City Hall and a public hearing on the proposed name changes was held on November 27, 2006 at the San Antonio Police Department, Prue Road Substation and no public notices nor public comments at the hearing were in opposition and the United States Postal Service approved the proposed name changes, therefore, the committee members voted unanimously in favor of the proposed name changes; and

WHEREAS, due to scheduling conflicts a public hearing on the issue was held after the prescribed ninety (90) day deadline, Council believes that the purpose for and input provided by the City Code procedures for renaming facilities and streets has been satisfied; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Certain procedures established by Chapter 2, Article VI, Sections 2-215 through 2-231, of the City Code for the deadlines for holding public hearings on proposed renaming of streets and facilities are waived only for this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The portion of De Zavala Road, in Council District 8, between Babcock and Maplepark Drive is hereby renamed "Bamberger Way." The portion of De Zavala Road, in Council District 8, between North Loop 1604 and NCB 14615, Blk 0, Lot 2 is hereby renamed "Bamberger Trail." The remainder of the roadway will continue to be known as De Zavala Road. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 3. The following fiscal impact will result from the passage of this ordinance:

- a) The funding for this expenditure is available in Fund 11001000 General Fund, Cost Center 2312020001 Traffic Signs - Installation/Maintenance, General Ledger 5301010 Maint. &

b) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.


